

# SCHOOL STARTING schedule



With different system and age requirements for preschool and starting school in every state and territory, it can get quite confusing as to when you should (or could) actually enrol your child. Refer to the article in our magazine (URL below) to find out the age requirements for your state and use our handy form to create a school starting schedule for your child. (Parents with children born before the cut-off month have the option of choosing which year their child starts school, as you can see in the table below.)

QLD TAS VIC WA	Kindergarten	Prep / Foundation (VIC) / Pre-Primary (WA)
